Psalm 139.1-11 *Domine, probasti*

- 1 O LORD, you have searched me out and known me; \*  
you know my sitting down and my rising up; you understand my  
thoughts from afar.
- 2 You examine my path and my places of rest, \*  
and are acquainted with all my ways.
- 3 Indeed, there is not a word on my tongue, \*  
but you, O LORD, know it altogether.
- 4 You have enclosed me behind and before, \*  
and have laid your hand upon me.

- 5 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, \*  
 so excellent I cannot attain to it.
- 6 Where shall I go then from your Spirit, \*  
 or where shall I flee from your presence?
- 7 If I climb up to heaven, you are there; \*  
 if I make my bed in the Grave, you are there also.
- 8 If I take the wings of the morning \*  
 and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,
- 9 Even there shall your hand lead me, \*  
 and your right hand shall hold me.
- 10 If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me," \*  
 then shall my night be turned to day.
- 11 Even the darkness is not dark to you, and the night is as clear as the day; \*  
 the darkness and the light to you are both alike.
